## HOW DO I REPORT THIS



### THE CAMPAIGN

The way universities handle reports of sexual violence is **not good enough**. We are lobbying for a mandatory **standardised process** for all UK universities to use when handling reports of sexual misconduct/offences.

### THE AIMS

1. **Identify and expose** the lack of consistency and transparency of the processes for reporting sexual violence within higher education across the UK.
2. **Provide students with information** about how they can report in the meantime (create a database).
3. **Lobby for a standardised process** to be implemented as a legal requirement



### WHY DOES STANDARDISATION MATTER?

At present, every university has a different process for reporting incidents of sexual misconduct. Some institutions impose a **time limit** within which a student must make an official report, which means by the time students come to terms with what has happened to them, they are often out of time. Many have multiple website pages about the reporting process that makes it **confusing and inaccessible** for students. Others **lack staff training** on sexual misconduct, meaning that even when students do report, they will not always be supported.

A standardised process for all universities would enable students to better understand their rights and ultimately increase access to justice.
